



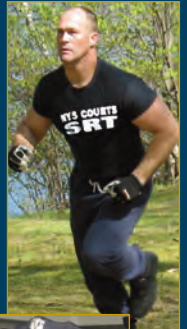

# New York State Court Officer

New York State Court Officers are highly trained law enforcement professionals responsible for the protection and security of judges, court employees and the public in courthouses and court facilities throughout New York State.



### RESPONSIBILITIES

Court Officers are required to carry firearms and are charged with providing law enforcement, security services and maintaining order within state court facilities. Court Officers have an opportunity to be assigned to specialized units such as the Special Response Team and Mobile Security Patrol.



### QUALIFICATIONS

To be appointed to the Court Officer Trainee position, candidates must pass a written examination and be at least 18 years old, a United States citizen, a New York State resident, and possess a High School Diploma or equivalent. Appointees must be legally eligible to carry a firearm in New York State. Candidates are called based on their final test score for a medical examination, psychological examination, physical ability examination and background investigation. Upon successful completion of this process, candidates are offered entry into the New York State Court Officers Academy.

### SALARY & BENEFITS

New York State Court Officer Trainees enter the Academy at Judicial Grade 14 (hiring rate for new list is \$39,771) and serve a two year traineeship. Upon successful completion of this traineeship, court officers automatically promote to Judicial Grade 18 at a salary of \$49,777.
